

Rebate Requirements

PSEG Long Island offers a wide array of incentives and rebates for residential customers to help reduce their energy usage and lower monthly bills. For a limited time, residential customers can receive rebates from PSEG Long Island through the purchase of eligible ENERGY STAR® certified and other selected products. Please refer to the below guidelines for rebate eligibility requirements:

- Customer must have a valid PSEG Long Island residential account number
- All required documents must be uploaded in appropriate application section
 - Dated sales receipt/paid invoice
 - Must show manufacturer, model number, and price paid
- Online rebate application must be completed within 45 days of purchase
- The rebate amount cannot be more than 50% of the retail purchase price paid
- Appliances must be ENERGY STAR or ENERGY STAR Most Efficient 2020 certified
- Account service address and installation address on receipt must match to receive rebate (if applicable)
- A PSEG Long Island representative may contact the account holder to schedule an on-site verification of installed equipment
- A PSEG Long Island representative may request photos of the installed equipment and of the nameplate on the equipment. Photos of the nameplate must clearly show the model and serial number of the installed equipment.

Pool Pump Requirements

- Must be a current ENERGY STAR Two-Speed or Variable Speed Pump, ½ horsepower or larger
- Pump must be installed by a participating dealer/installer who has completed the 2020 Letter of Agreement and obtained a manufacturer's training certificate. A complete installer list is located on the PSEG Long Island website, at psegliny.com/efficiency
- Pump must be purchased and installed between January 1 and December 31, 2020 (and may be subject to post inspection)
- Must be postmarked within 45 days of installation but no later than December 31, 2020

- You must be a PSEG Long Island residential customer.
- Account service address and installation address on receipt must match to receive this rebate.
- There is a limit of one rebate per year, per residential account. You must purchase your Electric Vehicle Charging equipment between January 1 and December 31, 2020.
- The rebate application must be sent in within 45 days of purchase but postmarked no later than December 31, 2020.

- Please allow up to 8 weeks for delivery of the rebate check.
- PSEG Long Island is not responsible for any tax liability imposed as a result of rebate payments.
- PSEG Long Island is not responsible for lost or undeliverable mail or email.
- PSEG Long Island reserves the right to use the customer rebate to credit accounts in arrears.

Your charging data will help PSEG Long Island manage the grid to maintain optimum efficiency. With this data we can anticipate where equipment upgrades are needed due to increased usage from electric vehicles.

Participants who charge their EV, at their service address, during residential off-peak hours will earn \$0.05 per kWh discount. Off Peak hours are 11PM to 6AM, Sunday through Saturday. Participants will receive rewards in the form of a credit to their electric service account on a quarterly basis.

Data Collected and Privacy

In order to conduct the Program and to provide participants with the products and services outlined in this agreement and appropriate customer service, and to enhance and improve these products and services, PSEG Long Island will collect and analyze information about your charging patterns start date and time, duration of charging session, charging power level (kW), total charging energy (total electricity consumed in kWh), 15-minute interval charging energy (kWh), starting state of charge, ending state of charge.
